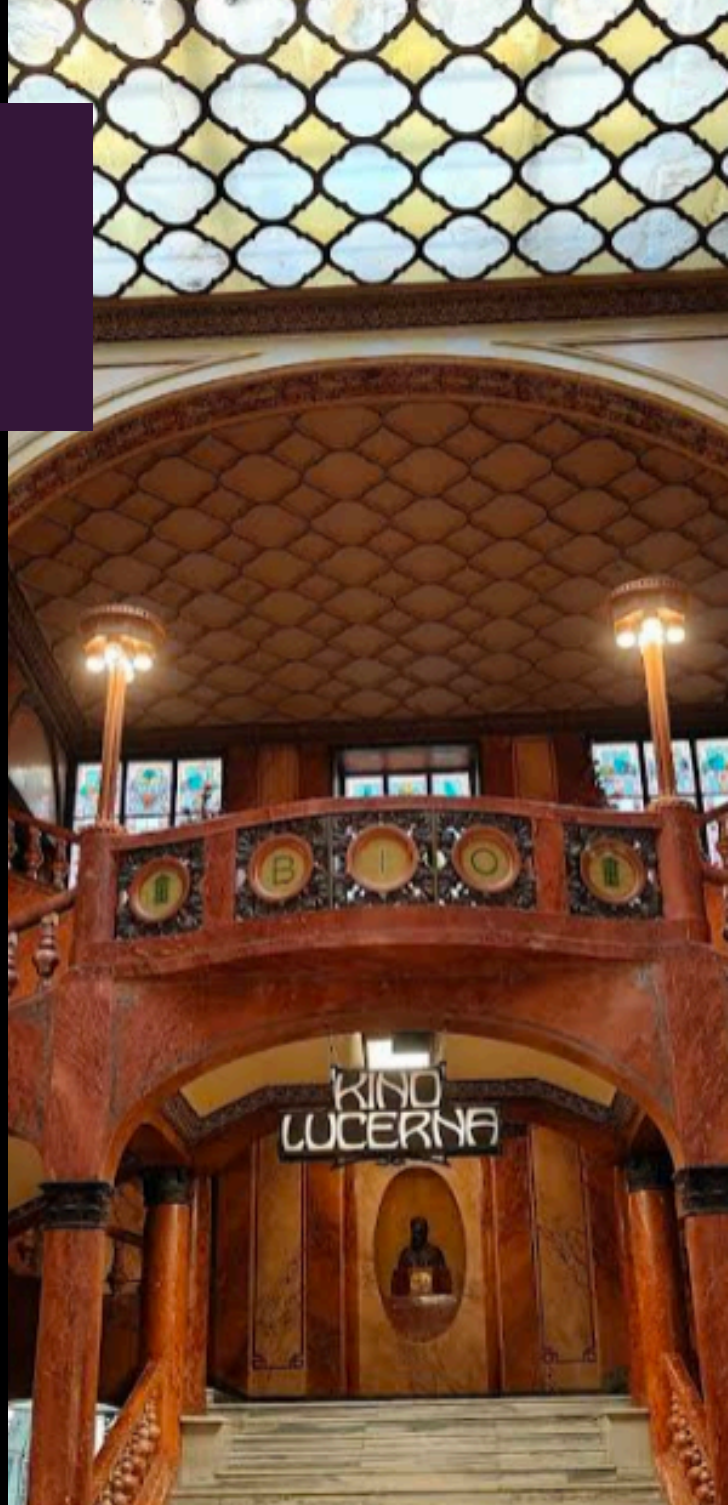

ABOUT THE VENUE

Located just off Wenceslas Square in the heart of Prague, Kino Lucerna is one of the city's most iconic and historic cinemas. Opened in 1909 as part of the grand Lucerna Palace complex, it is among the oldest continuously operating cinemas in Europe. The building was developed by the grandfather of future Czech president Václav Havel, and it remains a cultural landmark today. With its large Art Nouveau-style Great Hall and beautifully preserved interior details, Kino Lucerna offers a unique atmosphere that blends early 20th-century elegance with modern film culture.

"KŮŇ" (HORSE)

Created by David Černý, the sculpture is a parody of the famous statue of Saint Wenceslas.

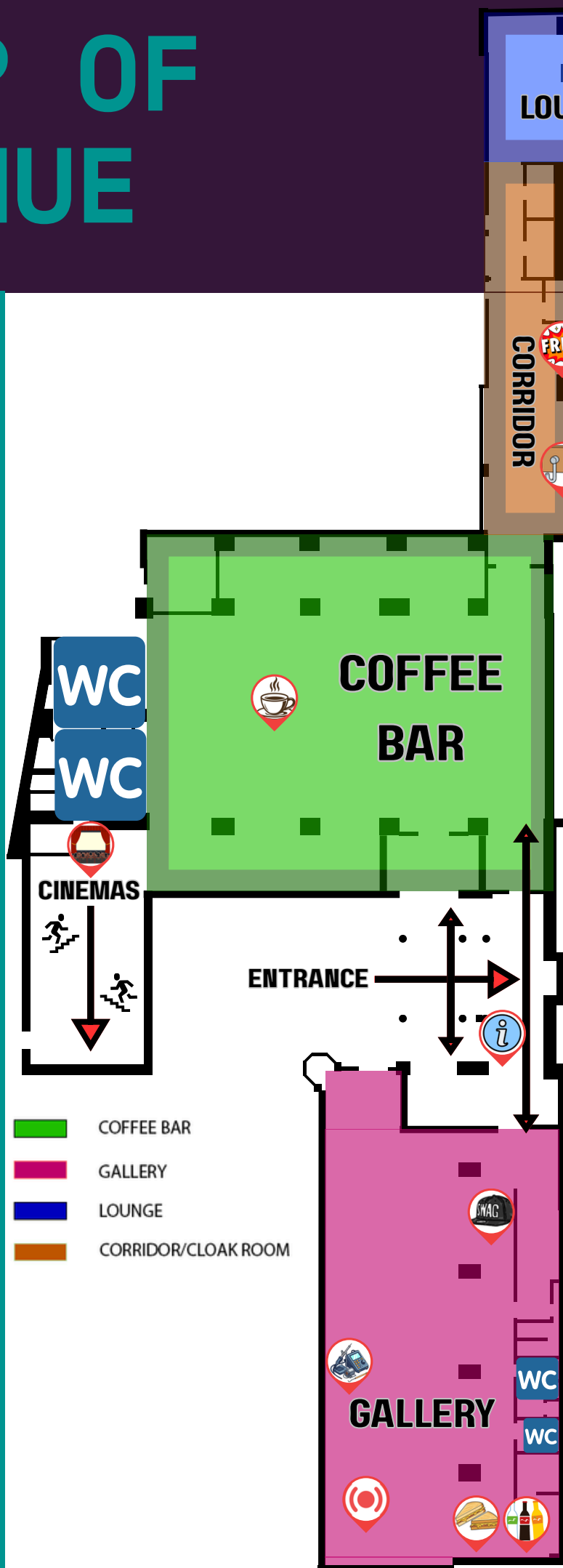

ARRIVAL



If you are arriving by car, you will have to **park further away and take public transportation** as there aren't many parking places downtown.



The **Central Train Station** (Praha hlavní nádraží) is located very close to the venue. You may either walk ~ 15 minutes (1km) or take the metro 1 stop to **Muzeum** (C line).



From the airport take **bus 59** to **Nádraží Veleslavín** and ride metro line A to **Můstek**.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IN PRAGUE

Metro, trams, and buses all covered by the same ticket system. Buy time-based tickets (30, 90 minutes, or 24/72 hours) and validate them once before your first ride.

Tickets can be purchased at metro station machines, kiosks, or via the PID Lítačka app, and inspectors frequently check for valid tickets.

Prague has 3 metro lines (**A–green**, **B–yellow**, **C–red**) running from 5:00 a.m. to midnight every 2–5 minutes during peak times. Take any line and get off at

- C** Muzeum

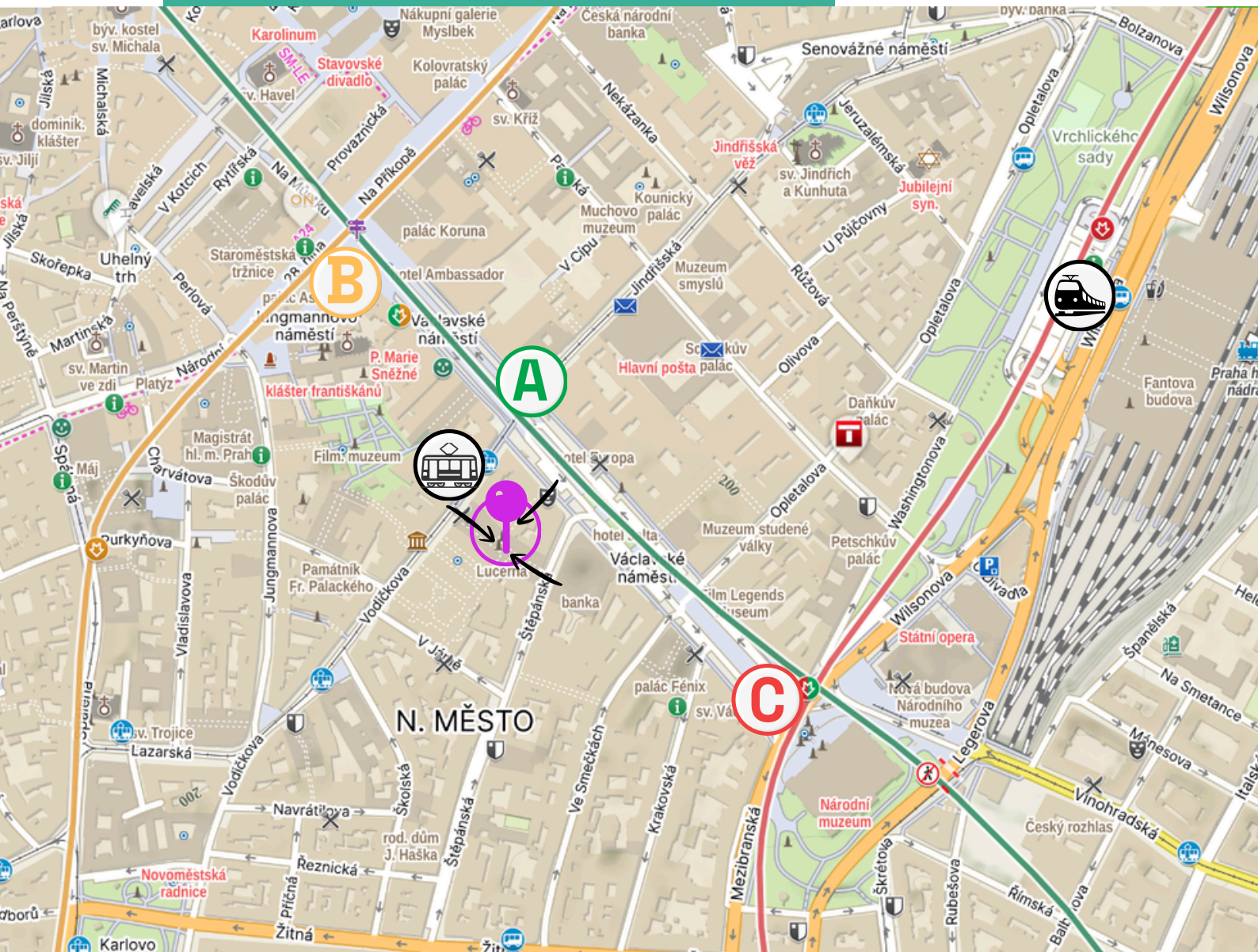

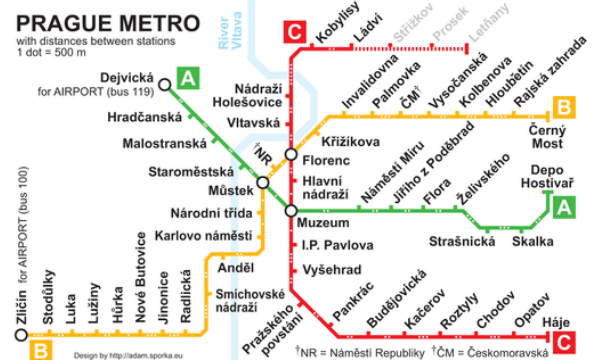
